#### **FREE DENTAL SEALANT DAY**

For Kids ages 6-13 on Saturday, February 4, 2012

The Lake Washington Dental Hygienists' Society is offering a preventive dental program, **Saturday, February 4, 2012, from 9am to 2pm**. This program is in honor of National Children's Dental Health Month. We will be providing **FREE** dental sealants, exams, bitewing x-rays, and fluoride varnish to children who would not otherwise be able to receive this cavity-prevention treatment. Children whose teeth are unable to be sealed due to decay may have their cavities filled at a later date.

Sealants are white coatings applied to the chewing surfaces of the back teeth. They are non-toxic and protect teeth from cavities. This process is *painless*, can protect your child's teeth for 6-8 years, and is usually done in less than an hour. **Registered Dental Hygienists** from the state of Washington **and Dental Hygiene Students** will place the sealants on your child's teeth.

The cost of this program is **FREE**. This includes all of the services mentioned above, a total value of over \$300 per child.

The clinic phone number is **(425)739-8130 - CALL NOW FOR AN APPOINTMENT** **Directions to the Clinic:** 11605 132<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE, Kirkland WA 98034 **From 405 Northbound:** Take Exit 18 (85<sup>th</sup> St), Take a right onto 85<sup>th</sup> St, Take a left onto 132<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE, LWTC is approximately 2 miles ahead on the left hand side. Look for LWDHS signs **From 405 Southbound:** Take Exit 20 (NE 124<sup>th</sup> St Exit), Left onto 124<sup>th</sup> St, Right onto Slater Ave NE; Left onto NE 120<sup>th</sup> St, NE 120<sup>th</sup> becomes 132<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE, Enter LWTC and watch for LWDHS signs.
