5th Grade Camp Important Information

5th Grade Camp at Camp Warm Beach in Stanwood, WA is only a week away! The 5th graders leave for camp on **Wednesday, May 28th** and return **Friday, May 30th**.

Things to Remember:

Thursday, May 22: Teachers will review “GO” Rules of camp and will provide samples of what to bring and ways to pack.

G: First warning call to parents

O: Second call for parents to come pick you up

Tuesday, May 27: Students will be given their cabin assignments. Please bring your child’s luggage to our drop-off area of the CRE parking lot between 4:30 P.M. and 5:30 P.M. All luggage will be packed into the vehicles by cabin assignments. Students should pack their gear into a duffle bag. Place the duffle bag, a sleeping bag, an extra garbage bag (for the trip home), and a pillow into a large garbage sack. Label this bag with your child’s name and cabin assignment. Tape or tie the garbage sack closed (twisty-ties seem to pop off).

Wednesday, May 28: Pack a large (the kids will be mighty hungry) sack lunch for your child. Chaperones need one for themselves as well. Make it a completely disposable lunch. Place the lunch in a plastic grocery bag that is clearly marked with your child’s name and cabin assignment. We will have a picnic lunch at camp shortly after our arrival. **Students should arrive at school at 7:40 A.M. on this day.** Parent chaperones who are driving should arrive at 7:45. **Our buses will leave promptly at 7:50.** If your child is absent from school on this day, we will assume that he/she will not be attending camp.

Friday, May 30: Students will arrive back at school between 1:30 and 2:00. You may pick up your child at this time. Students will check out through their teachers and will be dismissed per their “Going home from camp” plan.

CRE Class of 2014 Cast-Off Ceremony

The Cast-Off Ceremony for the 5th Grade class of 2014 will take place on **Monday, June 16th, at 9:00 a.m. in the Coyote Café**. This is a special time to celebrate your 5th grade student and their journey through elementary school!

Timeline:

8:30-8:45—Families line-up outside in front of the school

8:45-9:00—Doors open and families are seated in the Coyote Cafe

9:00-10:30—Cast-Off Ceremony

10:30-10:50—Reception & Photo opportunity for parents (don't forget your camera!)

If families would like to pull their younger children out of class to attend the Cast-Off ceremony they need to check them out of their class through the office and then check them back in through the office. **Reminder: Please do not park in the fire lane or delivery area.**

Suggested Attire:

Girls: Skirt or nice pants and blouse, or a dress. Standard dress code rules apply (tank top must be at least three finger width, length of dress or skirt should extend past fingertips when hands are down by side). Shoes should be comfortable enough that your daughter can easily walk up to receive her diploma.

Boys: No shorts. A collared shirt with long pants, preferably no jeans, but if your son has no other long pants then nice jeans.

After Cast-Off: Students will be more comfortable for the remainder of the day in regular clothes so please send in a change of clothes including shoes.
