5th Grade Service Project Update

During the week of February 22nd, we will kick-off our service project to the 5th grade students -- we are so excited for them to learn more about Project Linus! This effort will be a hands-on opportunity to reach out and touch our local community in a meaningful way.

There are 3 aspects to the service project:

Fundraising (Feb 23rd — Mar 11th) - Our goal is for each student to raise ~ \$20 for a total 5th grade goal of \$2,500. These fundraising dollars will go toward purchasing fleece and supplies for blanket making. Students can raise funds* by collecting quarters (coin drive) and/or through a variety of other individual or group activities—Dog Wash, Bake Sale, Lemonade Stand, etc.

More information will be provided via email from your room coordinator about when and where to drop off fundraising dollars.

Blanket Making—On March 15th, the 5th grade classrooms will be divided into two sessions to participate in the hands-on activity of making fleece blankets. At this time, 5th graders will also write a personal note which will be attached to each blanket.

<u>Donation</u>—The hand-made blankets our students make will be donated to Project Linus for distribution to children who are seriously ill, traumatized or otherwise in need.



These blankets provide love, a sense of security, warmth and comfort.

Any funds left over from the fundraising effort will be donated to Eastside Baby Corner.
