Service Project

▶ Children of the Nations

- ▶ is a nonprofit organization based in Silverdale, WA. They provide care for orphaned and destitute children in poverty-stricken areas of the world. Operating in Malawi, Sierra Leone, the Dominican Republic, Uganda, and Haiti, COTN helps early 7,000 children on a daily basis.
- ▶ Our students will be raising money to provide packaged meals at 25 cents per meal
- ▶ Goal is to raise \$3,000
- ▶ Students can raise funds through variety of individual or group activities: Dog Wash, Bake Sale, Lemonade
- ▶ Students will package meals once funds are collected.
