- NEW ONLINE DIRECTORY IS HERE!



We are excited to announce the release of a new feature to our school website. Our online directory is live and ready for use at cascaderidgeptsa.org. After logging into your website account, simply click on the "Online Directory" link on the left navigation bar and you can search by name for parents and/or students at Cascade Ridge. Note that this feature is only available to authorized website users who have an account at cascaderidgeptsa.org.

By default, if you are included in the school's printed directory, then all of the information you have previously submitted to the PTSA website will be available to online directory users. This information includes your name, address, phone number(s) and email address as well as the names of any children at Cascade Ridge, their grade and their teacher's name. You can choose to hide information about yourself by looking up your own name in the directory, and then clicking on the button next to the field that you want to hide. Once hidden, this information will not be visible to other users when they perform a search.

- SCRATCH coding




Nourish Every Mind Breakfast Draws Local Celebrity

Site Council Re-Cap and Bullying Resources



On Monday, February 10th the Cascade Ridge Site Council welcomed Chris Burton, Director of Labor Relations for the Issaquah School District, to speak about ISD's policies on bullying. Chris shared how he trains staff throughout the district on identifying bullying as well as intervention and prevention strategies. Staff throughout ISD take bullying very seriously and are well-trained to follow specific steps to resolve bullying situations in compliance with district policy and Washington State Law.

Chris maintains the Issaquah School District webpage on Bullying: Resources and Reporting and updates it every few months. He encourages families to visit the webpage for further information and resources on bullying and the districts policies. Chris shared this basic definition of what bullying is...

QUESTION: What is bullying? How do we define it?

ANSWER: Bullying is... when a student or students are being exposed, repeatedly and over time, to negative actions on the part of one or more students. Bullying exists when... there is intentional harm-doing, where a negative action is repeated over time; and there is an imbalance of power.

Harassment, intimidation or bullying is an intentional electronic, written, verbal, or physical act that:

- Physically harms a student or damages the student's property.
- Has the effect of substantially interfering with a student's education.
- Is so severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating or threatening educational environment.
- Has the effect of substantially disrupting the orderly operation of the school.

In addition to Chris's information and resources, our Cascade Ridge school counselor, Meredith Osborne updates her Connect website regularly and provides a variety of bullying resources including the link to the presentation that was shared with students at the Bullying assembly in February. All of Meredith's resource documents can be found on her website.
