ART - Anyone can be an Artist with twice the Clay – Mr. Crumpacker ALL NEW CIRRICULUM (1.5 HOUR CLASS)

The ability to create art is intrinsic. Everyone at any age can learn about and create fine art and communicate through visual art. Using drawing, painting and sculpture, students will explore a broad range of techniques, materials, and ideas that are formative and provide lifelong lessons in art. Experiences include drawing three dimensional objects, figures and self-portraits, and abstract approaches in drawing using a variety of painting mediums, collage, and sculpture. Students are encouraged to communicate their ideas and expand on them through visual media and above all to have fun and challenge themselves. Art history is discussed through books and printed materials. Mr Crumpacker has a Masters of Fine Arts from the University of Washington, he is a professional Artist and has been teaching art to students of all ages for 19 years. Every skill level is welcome. All art materials will be supplied.

Karate – Sensei Creech Teaching Team (1.5 HOUR CLASS)

Karate is a Japanese traditional form of martial arts which offers many benefits for the youth and adult. Foremost are exposure to the discipline of the sport, values such as fair play, respect for others as well as yourself, integrity, and character. Students are taught fundamentals to start the program and can advance to more difficult techniques and principles. Students who qualify for promotion to the next belt level can advance to match their skills. Students also learn leadership by leading particular activities as they gain skills. The teaching team is involved in ongoing training with Sensei Creech, a retired YMCA professional. He currently runs a karate program that teaches 200+ elementary school children in the area. The purchase of uniforms and promotions are encouraged yet optional. Information on purchasing uniforms and belt testing fees will be provided at the first class.

LEGO® – JR Engineers – Leap4kidz

LEGO Jr Engineers class offers an integrated STEM curriculum including science, technology, engineering, math, as well as history, language arts, and team decision making to children using LEGO® bricks and motors. This is a handson class where students will build and design with Legos and receive an introduction to levers, gears, pulleys, and more using batteries and motors to bring their creations to life!

MUSIC - Keiki Music Group Keyboard program – Musicianship development

Through a variety of activities in each class the students become independent musicians. In addition to playing the keyboards, the children will be involved in drumming and dance to nurture their rhythmic development, singing to nurture their tonal development, and echoing patterns to nurture their aural development. This program will prepare student for future piano study as well as other musical adventures the future holds! Class size limited to 8 students.
