The program starts Wednesday, January 11, 2023 at Summit Central Ski Area and continues for six consecutive weeks finishing on February 15, unless weather forces postponement. If a cancellation occurs, we automatically extend the program the number of trips missed.

The bus loads at school at 1:45 PM and returns at approximately 6:45 PM in the evening. Registration is limited to the first 40 applicants. Adult chaperones will be on the bus. This program is for second through fifth grade.

Classes begin at 3:00 P M and are 2 1/2 hours long. Lessons are taught by SSCS with thirty nine years of teaching experience in the greater Seattle area.
