 - Classroom Rewards are tied to MTSS practices and are generally voted on by each classroom.

MTSS Overview – Multi-Tiered Systems of Support

- o Goal is equitable outcomes for all students. See ISD Equity Statement
- o Tier 1 includes all students. Tiers 2 and 3 are students that need additional supports.
- o Examples of Tier 1 Behavior Supports SEL Lessons, Coyote Coins, Calming Corners, etc.

- Examples of Tier 1 Academic Supports Small group instruction, Academic specialist collaboration with grade level teachers (ML, Sage, LRC1, LAP), etc.
- Example Tier 2 Support Check in / Check out system (more intensive)
- o Principal Sehlin will include further information on Tiered Supports in an upcoming E-News.
- SEL Screener Tool SAEBRS New district-wide program this year (replaced existing screener). Teachers will screen students 3 times a year. Students in 2nd-5th grades will self-report as well.
 - Open Questions for Principal Sehlin:
 - Will parents see the students' self-reported answers?
 - Will this be performed before conferences?
 - Will ISD publish the data?

• We currently have 217 PTSA memberships for the year, out of 301 families at CRE. We are at 71%!

Anna Spurway – VP of Fundraising

- Mariner's game was a success! 72 Tickets sold for \$720 profit.
- School Tool Box We sold 148 boxes this year for \$686 profit.
- Coyote Wear met our minimum to process the order this fall.
- Brown Bear sold 40 tickets thus far.
- Upcoming Passive Fundraisers
 - o Mod Pizza Dine Out Night 11/16 We get 20% of the proceeds.
 - Holiday Evening at Snapdoodle We get 20% of proceeds during 2-hour shopping window.
- Adventure On Fundraiser
 - o Earned 70% of goal. Some pledged donations still pending. Used Cheddar Up to collect donations.
 - o Silent Auction proceeds of approx. \$5K. Used 32auctions for auction payments.
 - o Committee of 7 included 3 returning members and 4 new members this year.
 - o Communications included social media, email, web, signs, reader board, and honk and wave.
 - o Take home items included enamel pin and t-shirt for all students regardless of donation status.
 - Classroom competition was based on participation percentage (not donation amount).
 - o Classroom winners LaRusso, Trull and Page earned an indoor camping party in their classrooms.
 - o School-wide celebration assembly will be Friday with the student designed obstacle course.
